Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, an "after-the-fact" Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to relocate 90 linear feet (LF) of concrete pipe seawall landward up to 15 feet south of the existing seawall and construct 60 LF of new armor stone groin (3-5ton) along the east property line. The application was submitted by Robert C. & Maribeth M. DeFilippo. The project is located at 5855 Shore Drive in Madison. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is 2010-00264. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 123919.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, which is mostly installed, if approved, would allow the applicant to leave in place and finish constructing a relocated 90 LF concrete pipe seawall landward up to 15 feet south of where it was. Also finish constructing a new 73 LF armor stone groin (3-5 ton), top elevation 576.0 feet along the west property line and 30 LF of new armor stone groin (3-5) along the east property line and install 484 cubic yards of sand prefill above ordinary high watermark. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, which is already constructed, if approved, would allow the applicant to leave in place a relocated 90 LF concrete pipe seawall landward up to 15 feet south of where it was. Also constructed was a new 60 LF armor stone groin (3-5 ton), top elevation 574.7 feet along the west property line and 30 LF of new armor stone groin (3-5) along the east property line and install 484 cubic yards of sand prefill above ordinary high watermark. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Erie. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
