AMENDMENTS TO THE 2012 PROJECT PRIORITY LIST and LINKED DEPOSIT

OF THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND**

The Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency is providing notice of the addition of assistance proposals as amendments to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) priority list. The following applicants have indicated their intent to apply for financial assistance for their respective water quality improvement activities:

1. Akron (Summit County); \$3,000,000 for the second phase of large diameter sewer cleaning necessary to inspect and evaluate pipes. Akron will submit a condition assessment based on the inspection.
2. Portsmouth (Scioto County); \$300,000 for completion of a rate study and financial capability analysis to address 24/7 treatment operations, SSO, and CSO issues.

The addition of these activities to the priority list will not affect the potential for the WPCLF to provide assistance to other activities currently designated as Fundable on the WPCLF Intended Projects list during the current program year.

The interest rate on Link Deposit loans has now been reduced to zero percent (0%). NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to extract coal using conventional surface and auger mining methods at a 260 acre site. The application was submitted by Oxford Mining Company, LLC. The project is southwest of County Road 17 in Wells Township, Jefferson County. The Pittsburgh District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is LRP-2010-1242. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 123910.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 3,332 linear feet of intermittent stream, 158 linear feet of ephemeral stream and 0.04 acres of Category 2 wetlands. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would result in the filling of 2,013 linear feet of intermittent stream. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of unnamed tributaries to Rush Run. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
