Operable Unit 10 of the Diamond Shamrock Painesville Works Site
Painesville Township, Ohio
Public Meeting to be held.

On June 27, 2012, Ohio EPA issued a Preferred Plan concerning Operable Unit 10 (OU10) of the Diamond Shamrock Painesville Works Site (Site) located in Painesville Township, Lake County, Ohio. The Preferred Plan summarizes the history of the site and the investigation of contamination within the study area, provides an analysis of the feasibility of remedial alternatives, and outlines Ohio EPA's preferred alternative for remediation.

Ohio EPA's preferred remedial alternative presented in the Preferred Plan for OU10 includes:

- Requiring continued operation and maintenance of the existing landfill cap, ground water extraction system, perimeter security fence, and evaluation of shoreline erosion and slope stability through an Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Agreement with Ohio EPA.
- Requiring periodic monitoring of ground water monitoring wells located immediately outside the landfill cap to ensure that contaminants from the landfill do not migrate into Lake Erie or onto property surrounding the landfill.
- Establishing an Environmental Covenant (EC) that will prohibit construction of any structures on the surface of the landfill; prohibit residential land use and construction of buildings within 150' of the slurry wall installed on OU10; and prevent the extraction of ground water for potable and non-potable use.
- Developing a Risk Mitigation Plan (RMP) to address potential exposure to contaminated soils, ground water and other materials during future maintenance activities, as well as requiring that pre-trenching must be performed for any sub-surface work to be conducted within OU10.

Ohio EPA will hold a public meeting on Thursday August 16, 2012, to answer questions and to accept comments on the Preferred Plan. The public meeting will begin at 6:00 pm at the Lake County General Health District located at 33 Mill Street in Painesville, Ohio. The public meeting will begin with an information session during which Ohio EPA will present a summary of the Preferred Plan and answer questions. After the information session the public can submit oral or written comments for the record regarding the Preferred Plan.
