Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to fill streams and wetlands to construct a Medical Campus Development. The application was submitted by Mt. Carmel Health System. The project is located at 5525 Hoover Road in Grove City, Franklin County. The Huntington District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is LRH-2011-725-SCR. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 123917.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 1,206 linear feet of primary headwater habitat streams (930 linear feet perennial and 276 linear feet intermittent), 0.27 acres of wetlands, and 5.52 acres of ponds. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact 1,206 linear feet of primary headwater habitat streams (930 linear feet perennial and 276 linear feet intermittent), 0.27 acres of wetlands, and 5.52 acres of ponds; however, allowing the relocation of one stream in the central portion of the site. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.
