The permit contains requirements for applicants to prepare and implement storm water pollution prevention plans (SWP3s). The objective of requiring the SWP3 is to identify sources of potential storm water contamination and eliminate or minimize them. The permit also includes monitoring requirements.

Due to the nature of the discharges and requirements related to general NPDES permit development, this draft general NPDES permit meets an exclusion under the provisions of these rules.

Ohio EPA will hold a public hearing on the draft general NPDES permit at 10:30 AM on October 16, 2012 in Conference Room 6A, Ohio EPA Lazarus Government Center, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
