Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for construction of the JEF-John Scott Highway / Mall Drive project. The project includes improvements to approximately 5,910 linear feet of John Scott Highway beginning 500 feet south of State Route 43 and ending at Sinclair Avenue. Two culverts will be replaced on John Scott Highway near the intersection of Laretta Drive. The project also includes improvements to traffic signals and intersection improvements along Mall Drive between Fort Steuben Drive and John Scott Highway. The application was submitted by The City of Steubenville, 115 South Third Street, Steubenville, Ohio 43952.

The purpose of the proposed project is to reduce congestion, eliminate existing safety hazards, and maintain an efficient transportation facility. Much of the existing infrastructure including culverts, guardrail, pavement surface, and loop detectors has reached the end of their useful life. Ditches and roadway shoulders need to be restored to original conditions to ensure driver safety. Intersection improvements are necessary to balance traffic flow on John Scott Highway and Mall Drive and reduce congestion. This project will involve the impact of 1,156 linear feet of stream and 125 linear feet of ditch. The majority of impacts are associated with the relocation of the stream along John Scott Highway. This project is within the Willis Creek-Ohio River Watershed (12-digit HUC 05030101 11 09). The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Project Number is 2012-00074-OHR and the Ohio EPA SWIMS ID Number is 123997. The ODOT reference number for this project is JEF-John Scott / Mall Drive (PID 87380).

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would involve impacts to a total of 1,156 linear feet of four jurisdictional streams and 125 linear feet of jurisdictional ditch. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact a total of 130 linear feet of two jurisdictional streams. This reduction of impacts is the result of omitting roadway shoulder widening and traffic signal work. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state or U.S., but would not meet the purpose and need for the project.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of 1,156 feet of tributary streams within the Willis Creek-Ohio River Watershed (12-digit HUC 05030101 11 09). Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
