Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for construction of the JEF-7-5.00 project. The project involves slope stabilization along the western side of State Route 7 (SR 7) in Wells and Warren Township, Jefferson County, near Rayland Ohio. Rock slides are an ever-present danger along SR 7 due to abandoned mines located along the hillside which regularly fill with water, thus causing an increase in the hydrostatic pressure in the hillside. The increased hydrostatic pressure destabilizes the surficial rock and increases the risk of rock slides in the area. ODOT is proposing to reduce the grade of the slope through terracing and back stow the mine in order to stabilize soils and aggregates. Terracing the slope will minimize the threat to public safety by preventing further slope failure, catching rock or tree falls, and treating acidic water that's discharging from the abandon mine with limestone. In addition, SR 7 will be widened in order to accommodate a concrete barrier between northbound and southbound lanes to further enhance public safety. Three additional culverts will be installed beneath SR 7 to facilitate drainage adjacent to the road and prevent water from flowing on the road. The application was submitted by The Ohio Department of Transportation, 1980 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43223.

The purpose of the project is to minimize the potential for dangerous rock slides that have the potential to cause serious, if not fatal, accidents along SR 7. This project will involve the impact of 2,387 linear feet of stream. This project is within the Upper Ohio-Wheeling Watershed (8-digit HUC 05030106). The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Project Number is 2011-00771-OHR and the Ohio EPA SWIMS ID Number is 124016. The ODOT reference number for this project is JEF-7-5.00 (PID 81015).

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would involve impacts to a total of 2,387 linear feet of five jurisdictional streams. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact a total of 1,454 linear feet of four jurisdictional streams. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state or U.S., but would not meet the purpose and need for the project.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of 2,387 feet of tributary streams within the Upper Ohio-Wheeling Watershed (8-digit HUC 05030106). Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality.
