PROPOSED CONSENT ORDER**

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) and Woodell Inc. (“Defendant Woodell Inc.”) have entered into a proposed Partial Consent Order to resolve the First Amended Complaint filed against Defendant Woodell Inc. in the Monroe County Court of Common Pleas, Case Number 2011-362. The Complaint alleged that Defendant Woodell Inc. failed to monitor the effluent being discharged from the wastewater treatment plant (“WWTP”), failed to monitor the WWTP’s final sludge, and failed to maintain the WWTP in good working order. The proposed Partial Consent Order requires Defendant Woodell Inc. to comply with all applicable provisions of R.C. Chapter 6111 and pay a civil penalty of eleven thousand dollars (\$11,000).
