Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA)–Division of Surface Water (DSW) has issued a draft general National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. OHL000002 that may provide coverage to discharges from select household sewage treatment systems (HSTS) serving one, two or three family dwellings or other residential dwellings as defined by Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3701-29 in the state of Ohio. The draft general NPDES permit was issued on June 12, 2013. The Ohio EPA-DSW has developed this draft general NPDES permit through consultation with the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) and in conjunction with anticipated revisions to OAC 3701-29: Household Sewage Treatment Rules thru requirements established by Ohio Revised Code 3718.

The issuance of this draft general NPDES permit addresses the renewal of the existing NPDES Permit No. OHL000001 which expires on June 30, 2013. The issuance of general HSTS Permit No. OHL000001 addressed potential new or increased discharges of pollutants to waters of the state or a lowering of water quality/degradation to these receiving waters. However, chemical-specific water quality criteria developed to protect aquatic life and human health, set forth in OAC 3745-1, are not to be exceeded. In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review was conducted during the development of the general permit to determine the appropriateness and magnitude of coverage under the general permit and the associated potential lowering of water quality. Draft general NPDES Permit No. OHL000002 does not allow or expand the universe of potential new or increased discharges contemplated under general NPDES Permit No. OHL000001 and, therefore, an additional review under the provisions of OAC 3745-1-05 is not necessary in issuing this renewal general NPDES permit.

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has reviewed Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rules 3745-19-01 and 3745-19-04. These rules contain regulations for open burning in unrestricted areas.

Amendments are being made to these two rules to add language which would allow the use of Air Curtain Burners for the disposal of land clearing wastes via open burning. Specific information on the amendments to these rules can be found in the rule synopsis document, available electronically at the URL listed at the end of this notice. Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the division formally proposes them. On April 10, 2013, these rules went out for a 30 day review by interested parties. Ohio EPA received no comments on the draft rule language.

Pursuant to Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing on these rule changes will be conducted on July 12, 2013 at 10:30 AM at Ohio EPA Central office, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio 43215. All visitors to Ohio EPA must register at the Security desk in the lobby upon arrival. Please bring photo identification (such as a valid driver's license). For security reasons, visitors are required to wear their badge at all times while in the building. Please arrive early to complete these procedures.
