Issuance of Authorization for Statewide
Alternative Infectious Waste Treatment Approval

Notice is hereby given that on June 21, 2013, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3734.021 and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-38, the Director of Ohio EPA authorized the PIWS 3000 Medical Waste Treatment System from Medical Waste Recovery, Inc., 2069 Fletcher Ave., Fort Lee, NJ 07204 as an alternative treatment technology of infectious waste mixed with up to 8% pathological waste. Ohio EPA had previously authorized the PIWS 3000 alternative infectious waste treatment technology for state wide use on April 9, 2008. Medical Waste Recovery, Inc. by way of a letter dated January 25, 2013 proposed to modify the state wide alternative infectious waste treatment technology approval by requesting authority to add up to eight percent (8%) pathological waste. The Director has determined that the PIWS 3000 maintains the standards and requirements for a state wide alternative infectious waste treatment technology set forth in OAC Rule 3745-27-38. The Director has further determined that the proposed modification of the process to add up to a maximum of eight percent (8%) pathological waste will not alter the effectiveness of the state wide alternative infectious waste treatment technology. The PIWS 3000 state wide alternative infectious waste treatment technology is subject to the conditions and specifications set forth in the authorization and all applicable rules and regulations for infectious waste treatment and disposal.

This approval is subject to all rules, regulations, and specified conditions. This final action was not preceded by a proposed action and is appealable to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Directors action.
