NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to construct a single-family home subdivision as part of the final two phases (4 & 5) of a multi-phased residential subdivision. The application was submitted by Knight Development Corporation. The project is located east of Waite Farms Lane, City of Brunswick, Medina County. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is 2004-02250. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 113843.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 1.35 acres of category two wetlands and 421 linear feet of a class two intermittent stream for the construction of 90 single-family homes and 4 roads. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact 0.75 acres of category two wetlands and 246 linear feet of a class two intermittent stream for the construction of 69 single-family homes and 3 roads. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the East Branch Rocky River. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
