

Public Hearing Notice – Request for Comment
Amended Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-09
Amendment to Allow Decommissioning of Existing Stage II Vapor Recovery
Systems

Please note that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has reviewed Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-09, “Control of emissions of volatile organic compounds from stationary sources and perchloroethylene from dry cleaning facilities” and is proposing amended rule language to the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR).

Ohio EPA has changed rule language in paragraph (DDD) of this rule which would allow and set forth procedures through which existing Gasoline Dispensing Facilities (GDFs) could decommission their Stage II vapor recovery systems. The draft amendments also call for all existing GDFs to decommission their Stage II systems by January 1, 2017.

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the division formally proposes them. On September 5, 2013, these rules went out for a 30 day review by interested parties.

Pursuant to Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing on these rule changes will be conducted on Friday, December 6, 2013 at 10:30 AM at Ohio EPA Central office, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio 43215. All visitors to Ohio EPA must register at the Security desk in the lobby upon arrival. Please bring photo identification (such as a valid driver's license). For security reasons, visitors are required to wear their badge at all times while in the building. Please arrive early to complete these procedures.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented at the hearing and give written or oral comments on these rule changes. All oral comments presented at the hearing, and all written statements submitted at the hearing or by the close of business on December 6, 2013 will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rule. Written statements submitted after December 6, 2013 may be considered as time and circumstances permit, but will not be part of the official record of the hearing.
