TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD REPORT**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) is providing for public review and comment the Sandusky River (lower) and Bay Tributaries Watershed Total Maximum Daily Load Report (TMDL) Document. Ohio EPA developed the Document in fulfillment of Section 303(d) of the Clean Water Act, which requires the identification of impaired waterbodies for which technology-based effluent limitations are not stringent enough to achieve applicable water quality standards and to develop Total Maximum Daily Loads for such waters. The Document addresses impairments in the lower Sandusky River and Sandusky Bay tributaries watershed that appear on the Ohio 2012 303(d) list (assessment units 04100011 01 01 through 03, 04100011 02 01 through 05, 04100011 09 01 through 05, 04100011 10 01 through 04, 04100011 11 01 through 05, 04100011 12 01 through 03, 04100011 13 01 through 03, 04100011 14 01 through 05). The impaired waters are located in Erie, Hancock, Huron, Ottawa, Sandusky, Seneca, and Wood counties.

Composting Facilities**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Section 119.032 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapter 119, proposes to original file the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code:

3745-560-130	Compost quality standards for class I composting facilities.
3745-560-230	Compost quality standards for class II composting facilities.
3745-560-330	Compost quality standards for class III composting facilities.

This rule addresses composting regulations.

The purpose of this rule making is to correct two errors in the three compost quality standards rules in Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 3745-560. "Table 1 – heavy metals" in rules 3745-560-130, 3745-560-230, and 3745-560-330 as written, contain typographical errors. The errors are identical in each rule and include the following:

1. The Selenium analytical methods column is missing "6020A" after the "SW-846" method.
2. The Zinc analytical methods column is missing a "SW-846" before method "6020A."

The public comment period will run until May 28, 2014. A public hearing on this proposed rulemaking will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. This hearing will be held at May 28, 2014 at 10:30 a.m. at Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 50 W. Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio.

To facilitate the scheduling of oral presentations, persons intending to give testimony at the hearing should notify the Ohio EPA Public Interest Center, P.O.
