Proposed Update to Ohio's Water Quality Management (208) Plan**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection is proposing to update water quality management plans, as required by Sections 303 and 208 of the Clean Water Act. These plans describe and promote efficient and comprehensive programs for controlling water pollution from point and nonpoint sources in a defined geographic area. This update includes a newly delineated facility planning area in northwest Licking County and updated 208 Plans from the following Areawide Councils of Governments:

- **Eastgate Regional Council of Governments;**
- **Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments;**
- **Ohio Kentucky Indiana Regional Council of Governments;**
- **Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency; and**

The State of Ohio prepares and maintains the 208 Plan applicable in the remaining 64 counties. The Governor then certifies the entire 208 Plan via submission to U.S. EPA for their approval.

**Ohio EPA Issues Preferred Plan for**  
**Hilltop Landfill, Ellsworth Township, Ohio;**  
**Public Meeting to be held**

On April 14, 2014, Ohio EPA finalized a Preferred Plan concerning the Hilltop Landfill site located north of U.S. Route 224 in Ellsworth Township (approximately 1.5 miles west of Canfield), Mahoning County, Ohio. The Preferred Plan summarizes the history of the site and the investigation of contamination at the site, provides an analysis of the feasibility of remedial alternatives, and outlines Ohio EPA's preferred alternative for remediation.

The Hilltop Landfill (aka Old Toth Landfill) is located on approximately 20 acres and was formerly a coal strip mine. The landfill operated between 1969 and 1976 and accepted household, commercial, agricultural, light industrial, institutional and construction wastes. Contaminants include volatile and semi-volatile organic compounds, pesticides and ammonia. Contamination in the form of leachate seeps is also entering a nearby unnamed creek.

The major components of the preferred remedial alternative include: landfill cover improvements and leachate collection system enhancements and associated long-term operations and maintenance, ground water monitoring, and activity and use limitations through an environmental covenant for use of the property and related ground water and soil gas issues.

Ohio EPA will hold a public meeting on Thursday May 29, 2014, to answer questions and to accept comments on the Preferred Plan. The public meeting will begin at 6:30 p.m. at the Ellsworth Township Town Hall, located at 11125 W. Akron Canfield Road, North Jackson, Ohio 44451. The public meeting will begin with an information session during which Ohio EPA will present a summary of the Preferred Plan and answer questions. After the information session the public can submit oral or written comments for the record regarding the Preferred Plan.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to construct a 37-acre mixed use planned unit development. The application was submitted by Liberty South Development, LLC. The project is located at 7451 Liberty Way, West Chester, Ohio. The Huntington District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is LRH 2014-237 GMR. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 144367.

As required by the Anti-degradation Rule, 3745-1-05, of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 267 linear feet of intermittent stream, 1.37 acres of Category 1 Wetlands. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact 0.62 acres of Category 1 Wetlands. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Gregory Creek. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an anti-degradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to reconstruct, widen, and improve 4 miles of interstate 70 and improve the SR 48/I-70 interchange. The application was submitted by the Ohio Department of Transportation. The project is located along interstate 70 in Butler Township, Montgomery County. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 134313.

As required by the Anti-degradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 226 linear feet of perennial, exceptional warm water habitat, superior high quality water stream (Stillwater River) and 0.1 acres of category 2 wetland. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact 220 linear feet of perennial, exceptional warm water habitat, superior high quality water stream (Stillwater River) and 0.07 acres of category 2 wetland. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Stillwater River. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an anti-degradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
