Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.03 has adopted amended rules contained in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-25, "Ambient Air Quality and Emergency Episode Standards."

The rules in OAC chapter 3745-25 establish the ambient air quality standards and emergency episode standards which the state of Ohio will use to attain and maintain the national ambient air quality standard (NAAQS) as required under Section 110 of the Clean Air Act (CAA).

The amended rules include various minor fixes to correct typos and update formatting to comply with Legislative Services commission (LSC) conventions were made along with necessary updates to reflect newly enacted national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS). These minor changes were made after a review to fulfill the requirements of ORC 119.032 (5-year review).

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, Ohio EPA was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the division formally adopts them. On July 21, 2014, these rules and the draft business impact analysis document went out for a 30 day review by interested parties. The rules were also released for a 30-day proposal comment period ending October 21, 2014 and a public hearing was held on October 21, 2014. No comments were received and no testimony was given at the hearing.

The Director's order of adoption was issued on November 21, 2014. The effective date of the adoption is December 1, 2014.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to construct a mixed-use development consisting of commercial uses, including but not limited to retail as well as industrial uses. The application was submitted by J.J.J. Properties, LLC. (the Applicant). The 33 acre project site is located at 6001 Vrooman Road in the Leroy Township, Lake County, Ohio. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is 2009-01681(0). The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 144497.

As required by the Anti-degradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three design alternatives have been submitted for the project. The Applicant's proposed Preferred Alternative, if approved, would impact 1,775 linear feet of perennial stream and 1.451 acres of Category 2 wetlands. The Applicant's proposed Minimal Degradation Alternative, if approved, would impact 651 linear feet of perennial stream and 1.047 acres of Category 2 wetlands. The Applicant's proposed Non-degradation Alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Grand River. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an anti-degradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
