This action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (the "Commission") pursuant to ORC 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to surface mine an approximately 187.6 acre site to recover the Pittsburgh # 8 coal seam by contour and auger mining. The application was submitted by Oxford Mining Company, LLC (Applicant). The project is located within Knox Township, Jefferson County. The Pittsburgh District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is 14-41. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 144537.

The Applicant's proposed preferred alternative would impact the following: 1,620 linear feet of perennial stream, 1,896 linear feet of intermittent stream, 374 linear feet of ephemeral stream, and 0.064 acres of Category 2 jurisdictional wetlands. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative would impact the following: 1,620 linear feet of perennial stream, 1,189 linear feet of intermittent stream, 374 linear feet of ephemeral stream and 0.064 acres of Category 2 jurisdictional wetlands. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity may result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Carter Run, a tributary to Hollow Rock Run. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32.

PUBLIC NOTICE Ohio EPA Preferred Plan for Hamilton Standard Controls, Lexington, Ohio; Public Comment Period Extension

On October 30, 2014, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) issued a Preferred Plan concerning the Hamilton Standard Controls Site located at 147 Plymouth Street in Lexington, Richland County, Ohio (Site). The Preferred Plan summarizes the history of the Site and the investigation of contamination at the Site, provides an analysis of the feasibility of remedial alternatives, and outlines Ohio EPA's preferred alternative for remediation.

The Site was historically used for manufacturing activities which included metals machining and electronic component fabrication between 1953 and 1995. These activities contributed to the release of contaminants into soil and ground water at the Site. The preferred remedial alternative includes soil vapor extraction, air sparging of the ground water, ground water use restrictions, building occupancy restrictions, and limitations on the future use of the former facility property.

Ohio EPA held a public meeting on Tuesday, December 16, 2014, to answer questions and to accept comments on the Preferred Plan. Originally, Ohio EPA was accepting written comments through December 24, 2014. The public comment period now extends through January 26, 2015.
